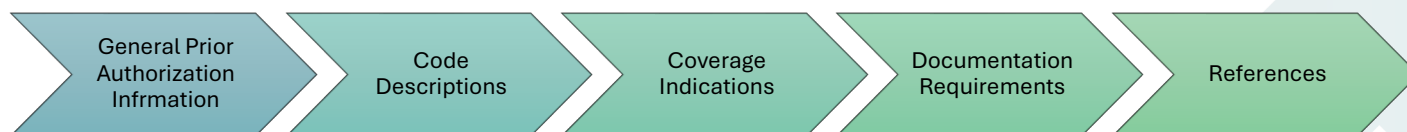
How long does an E-visit last?
