

CLINICIAN CHECKLIST FOR EXTERNAL BREAST PROSTHESES

The treating clinician must complete the following items:

Standard Written Order (SWO)

Medical records as noted below

Medical Documentation

Documentation of a past mastectomy or breast absence supporting medical necessity with one of the covered diagnosis codes listed in the External Breast Prostheses-Policy Article A52478

A prosthesis or related item's diagnosis code

Original surgical documentation isn't necessary

If ordering a different type of breast prosthesis for a beneficiary who already has one, document the beneficiary's medical condition change, which explains the need for a different type of breast prosthesis

The LCD does not specify the quantity of bras or camisoles that are covered. A physician determines what is reasonable and necessary on a case-by-case basis. Medical records should reflect and support what is ordered and dispensed to a beneficiary.
