

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) may elect to exempt a DMEPOS supplier from the prior authorization (PA) process upon a supplier's demonstration of at least 90% compliance for initial requests with Medicare coverage, coding, and payment rules. This exemption would remain in effect until CMS elects to withdraw the exemption.

PA requests submitted by a DMEPOS supplier while the supplier is temporarily exempt will result in a rejected request. Suppliers who wish to continue to submit PA requests may choose to opt out of the exemption program no later than April 30. Once a supplier opts out, they will not be eligible to re-enter the temporary exemption until they achieve compliance during the next standard annual cycle.
