

Medicare Intravenous Immune Globulin Demonstration

Medicare invites you to participate in a 3-year demonstration project ending December 31, 2020 to study the impact of paying for the administration of Intravenous Immune Globulin (IVIG) drugs in the convenience of your own home.

Overview

If you're enrolled in the IVIG demonstration, Medicare will pay a bundled payment for supplies and related nursing services to administer your IVIG medication in your home. Participation in this demonstration won't affect any of your other Medicare benefits. Participation in this demonstration is voluntary – you can withdraw at any time.

Am I Eligible?

To be considered for the IVIG Demonstration, ask yourself these questions:

- Are you enrolled in Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance)?
- Do you have original Medicare (Medicare Part A – Hospital Insurance and Part B) and are **not** enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan (like an HMO or PPO)?
- Do you have a diagnosis of Primary Immune Deficiency Disease (PIDD)?
- Do you take intravenous immune globulin for your PIDD and want to get it at home **or** do you get immune globulin by injection under the skin (subcutaneously) and want to switch to intravenous administration?
- Are you currently **not** covered under a home health episode of care because you are homebound?

If your answer is “**yes**” to **all** of the above, complete, sign and submit an enrollment application if you wish to be considered for the demonstration. Submitting an application for this demonstration does not guarantee we will select you to participate.

How Do I Participate?

You must complete, sign and submit an application to be considered for the demonstration, as space and funding is limited. Both you and your physician must sign the application.
